IF YOU ARE ACCEPTING THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ON BEHALF OF YOUR EMPLOYER, YOU REPRESENT AND WARRANT THAT YOU HAVE FULL LEGAL AUTHORITY TO BIND YOUR EMPLOYER.

#### 1 OVERVIEW

By using any portion of the Portal, you are accepting the General Terms and Conditions of Use ("terms") provided herein. If you do not agree with these terms for any reason, you are asked not to use the Portal or its services. Use of the Portal and/or its services indicates your acceptance of these terms. The *Dev Team* reserves the right to update or modify these terms at any time without notice. #### 2 COPYRIGHT AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

4 copies thereof, including copyrights, patents, trade secret rights, trademarks and other

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7 The structure, organization, codes and functionalities of the Portal are valuable trade secrets

8 of immense commercial value; and they are confidential information belonging to *The Dev* 

*Team*. You acknowledge that the Portal is licensed for use, not sold to you. *The Dev Team* 

reserves all intellectual rights to the Portal, including those not expressly granted to you in

this terms and conditions of use.

#### 3 NON-EXCLUSIVE LICENSE

As a paid or unpaid account holder, *The Dev Team* grants you a non-exclusive license to

access and use the services deployed on the Portal. The Dev Team reserves the right to

terminate this license at any time for any reason. This right will generally be practiced when

abuse of the services or nonpayment of fees due has been determined.

#### 4 INCREMENTAL DEVELOPMENT AND UPGRADE POLICY

Any major version release of the Portal is built on a modular architecture which consists of a

finite number of technologies, functionalities and/or processes defined by *The Dev Team*.

This finite number of technologies, functionalities and/or processes work together to deliver

the features and services you enjoy on the Portal. Depending on when you subscribe to the

Portal, all of the components may or may not be available to you. Any missing components

shall be made available in piecemeal method over the development timeline set for that

major version release by *The Dev Team*.

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As part of our fundamental policy of producing only software that conforms with world-class

software engineering standards and best practices, we allow any component to be

integrated into the system and made available for your use when and only when the

29 component has gone through and passed all of our many rigorous quality measurement and

assurance procedures. You understand and accept that such processes may not always take

an exactly predictable length of time to complete.



The Dev Team usually will notify you of new components or plug-ins that become ready for integration onto your version of the Portal through e-mail or on-site messages; and The Dev Team shall proceed to upload the components or plug-ins as soon as they are ready without necessarily seeking your permission to proceed with the updates. Such updates will usually take less than two hours to be completed. During such updates however, The Dev Team may temporarily make the Portal unavailable for use; but services shall be restored immediately upon completion of the update. You understand and accept this occasional disruption of services due to system updates.

#### 5 BILLING AND REFUND POLICY

The *Dev Team* charges and collects money for use of the Portal, either directly or indirectly. The payment amount might be a fixed flat rate or it might be determined by your subscription level. Payment amount will be calculated from the *ATLANTIS SchoolManager* schedule of service fees and charges or "as quoted". *The Dev Team* reserves the right to modify the schedule of service fees and charges at any time, and any such change will come into effect immediately for new subscribers and upon the subscription renewal for existing subscribers.

While the subscription is not delinquent and these terms remain in force, your subscription will be automatically renewed upon the completion of the subscription period, and where you are responsible for payment, you will be invoiced in accordance with the schedule of fees in force at that time, excepting the case where your service is subject to a quotation or a written pricing agreement signed by a Managing Member of *The Dev Team*. Any such negotiated pricing terms are confidential and may not be disclosed to a third party. If you believe your invoice is incorrect for any reason, you must contact *The Dev Team* within 30 days of the subscription renewal to be eligible to receive an adjustment or credit.
